



Hi! I'm Advisy — I'm here to fish out the information you need about your rights and digital protection. But before we dive in, there are few important things you need to know.

I'm an AI.

I am an Artificial Intelligence. I am trained to give you information about your rights, digital protection, and the work of human rights defenders. I can make mistakes, so always double-check important information.

I'm not a human being, and I'm not your friend.

I'm a chatbot, operated by a company called Chatbase. I can give you information, but I can't be your companion or your emotional support. For that, please reach out to a real human you trust.

My information is general.

What I share is based on international standards, like UN Conventions. Laws and rights vary between countries and can change. Before taking any action, please verify the situation in your country with a trusted local organisation.

Don't share information that identifies you!

Please don't share your name, location, school, organisation, or details about specific incidents. But Personal Identifiable Information (PII) goes beyond that — the issues you raise, the language you use, and the details you describe can also reveal who you are. Share only what you need to.

Be aware of how your data is handled!

When you close your browser or leave the chatbot unattended for a few minutes, this conversation will automatically disappear from your device. However, it is stored on the chatbot's server for 30 days. During this period, it can be accessed by Child Rights Connect staff for monitoring purposes, and in limited circumstances by Chatbase's technical team for operational reasons.

Closing the browser is not enough.

When you close the browser, the conversation itself will disappear. However, the trace of the website visit and the chatbot may still remain in your browser history. To remove it, clear your browser history (Ctrl+Shift+Delete on most browsers).

Who else could see this?

If you are using a shared device or a computer at school, the previous step is especially important — make sure you clear your browser history when you are done. Also pay attention to your surroundings: could someone walk in and see your screen while you are chatting?

You think you're being monitored?

If you have reason to think your device or connection is being watched, use a VPN before accessing this chatbot. You can find guidance on this [HERE](#) or in my resources.

In a crisis? I can't call for help.

I'm not an emergency tool and I cannot contact anyone on your behalf. If you are in immediate danger, please talk to a trusted adult or contact a trusted local human rights organisation directly.

Real people check my work.

Staff at Child Rights Connect periodically review conversations to make sure I'm working safely and giving you accurate information. Your privacy is protected during these reviews.
